
How to take a photo of yourself holding your Identity Document

- 1. Photos are best taken with a mobile phone to provide a clear image.
- 2. Photo should be taken up close, to only include your shoulders, head, and the identity document.
- 3. Ensure that the photo is of a clear quality, taken in a well-lit area or lots of natural light.
- 4. Hold the identity document next to your cheek.
- 5. Make sure both your face and ID are clear in the photo nothing on the ID can be covered or censored. (by your fingers)
- 6. The contents on your identity document need to be clear and legible.
- 7. Please check that the photo meets the guidelines in the previous steps before submitting as the photo will not be accepted.
